Manufactured news

Similar to "fake news," a term popularized by former U.S. President Donald J. Trump, "manufactured news" is any news wherein a news organization will fabricate a news story for its own political or strategic advantages, such as for the purpose of inflating ratings or to fleetingly promote hidden political agendas. Likewise, news organizations may collaborate with individuals, corporations, or governments to manufacture news. The latter may occur when there's a shared mutual interest between all parties involved.
